\* ABCR includes all Patients with Breast Cancer/DCIS first identified after June 2000 in the Auckland region

- improve use of health sector dollar








# **Age Distribution**



# Severity (NPI) by Age




# Screening vs. Lump Detection Comparison


# Surgery by Age



# **Ethnicity Comparison**


